## **Professor Goswami Receives Prestigious Faculty Award**

*He is the recipient of the Theodore and Venette Askounes-Ashford Distinguished Scholar Award*

**Tampa, Fla. (March 29, 2011)** – Prof. Yogi Goswami, Co-Director of the Clean Energy Research Center, has been named recipient the 2011 USF Theodore and Venette Askounes-Ashford Distinguished Scholar Award, which will be formally awarded at a fall 2011 ceremony.

This award is made to USF faculty members whose careers have brought them national distinction. The award is made via the Faculty Senate Honors and Awards Council.

*The University of South Florida is one of the nation's top 63 public research universities and one of only 25 public research universities nationwide with very high research activity that is designated as community engaged by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching. USF was awarded \$394.1 million in research contracts and grants in FY 2009/2010.
