



## ACCELERATED BS AND MASTER'S PROGRAMS IN CIVIL AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING

Thesis and non-thesis Master's degrees in Civil Engineering (MCE & MSCE) and Environmental Engineering (MSEVE & MSEVE).

A Master's degree is recommended by the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE).

### REQUIREMENTS:

- 131 hours of undergraduate coursework
- 30 hours of graduate coursework or 24 hours of coursework and six credits of thesis
- Students who maintain a GPA of 3.3 or higher may double count two undergraduate courses to meet their graduate coursework requirements
- Students may apply at the end of their junior year
- The program is restricted to undergraduates with a 3.0 GPA or higher

### THIS PROGRAM OFFERS:

- Flexibility in course scheduling
- The graduate degree requirements are reduced from 30 to 24 credit hours if the GPA is maintained at 3.3 or higher throughout the Master's program

### STUDENTS MAY OBTAIN:

- MCE or MEVE with coursework only
- MSCE or MSEV with coursework and a six hour thesis

### DETAILS:

- Professional development courses such as Principles of Engineering Management can be taken from the Department of Industrial Engineering or from the College of Business Administration.
- Electives can include courses offered by the Department or courses offered by other departments at USF.
- Students can use two undergraduate 4000 level courses in their Master's program.
