

Career Center Fairs and Services

Career Networking Fair: The Career Fair is a semi-annual campus-wide event with design to highlight companies, non-profit organizations and government agencies; and provide opportunities to enhance relationships between employers, students and alumni. Employers frequently advertise full-time, co-op and internship opportunities to students and alumni. The Fair is held at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters, and typically from 150 to 200 organizations and 1800 job seekers attend this fair. Employers pay a fee that includes vendor space (table and chairs), parking pass, and breakfast and lunch for two representatives.

Prepare for the Fair: Employers may elect to participate in “Prepare for the Fair” which is a prelude event to the Career Networking Fair. This event is held the week prior to the Career Fair with the goal to prepare students for the Fair. Employers are invited to present a career topic such as “How to Interview at a Networking Fair.”

Public Service Career Fair: This Fair is a semi-annual campus-wide event that is similar to the Career Networking Fair with design to highlight only Public Service Employers. The Fair is held in the fall and spring semesters. Employers pay a fee that includes vendor space (table and chairs), parking pass, and lunch for one representative.

Both the Career Center and the College advertise the Fair on the Career Center website (www.career.usf.edu), through e-mail distribution to the students, announcements to teaching faculty, and distribution of flyers throughout the College. The Career Networking Fair is managed through the Career Center.

Engineering EXPO: Engineering EXPO is the USF College of Engineering’s Celebration of National Engineering Week (<http://expo.eng.usf.edu>). Usually held the third weekend of February, EXPO is designed to educate elementary, middle and high school students and the general public on how math, science, engineering and technology affect our everyday lives. EXPO showcases exhibits from engineering student societies, organizations and local companies to illustrate the fun in engineering. Engineering EXPO offers profit and nonprofit organizations the opportunity to exhibit their products and services to the engineering and educational community of the Tampa Bay area. Exhibitors receive exhibit space (with table and chairs) and acknowledgement on the EXPO homepage at no charge.
